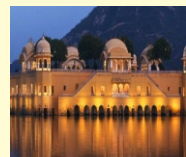


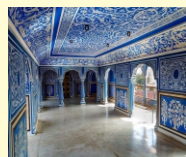

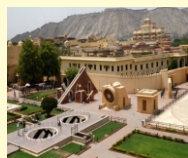

### About RUSA Programme 2.0

Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), launched in 2013 and operates in mission mode for funding the State Government Universities and Colleges to achieve the aims of equity, access and excellence, at providing strategic funding to eligible state higher educational institutions. RUSA would create new Universities through upgradation of existing autonomous colleges and conversion of colleges in a cluster. It would create new model degree colleges, new professional colleges

and provide infrastructural support to universities and colleges. Faculty recruitment support, faculty improvement programmes and leadership development of educational administrators are also important components of the scheme. A separate module to synergise vocational education with higher education has also been included in RUSA. Besides these, It also supports reforming, restructuring and building capacity of institutions in participating state. The funding to states would be made on the basis of critical appraisal of State Higher Education Plans, which would describe each state's strategy to address issues of equity, access and excellence in higher education.

### Conference Concept Note

The vision of higher education in India is to realize the country's human resources potential to its fullest with equity and inclusion. The higher education sector, in recent decades, has witnessed a tremendous growth in many aspects such as its institutional capacity, enrolment, teacher-student ratio, etc. The rapid expansion of the higher education system at the same time has brought several pertinent issues related to equity, efficiency, excellence and access to higher education in the country.
